RAIN broadcasts the award-winning CAMP INTERNET Program to schools in four western states and has recently been funded to start a pilot project that expands this fun learning program to selected afterschool sites. **The communities of Oxnard, Santa Barbara, Guadalupe, Oceano, and Cuyama will be the direct beneficiaries of this new project.** funded jointly by the California Consumer Protection Foundation, The Money/Arenz Foundation, and the RAIN Network. The project's learning themes includes **"Explore the California Channel Islands"** and is rich in online and hands-on social studies, science, art, literature and technology learning activities. This Internet-based project will run March-June, and then expands to add **"Explore the Global Garden"** June-August, with a new **GPS / GIS Mapping** community and environmental mapping project September- December.

Up to 300 students who complete this program will then earn a free pass on an amazing Floating Marine Lab Oceanography Trip out of Oxnard Harbor ! Each student enrolled gets their own materials pack with hands-on learning activities all session long. Each site also receives display materials to excite student interest, and a custom learning activities kit.

This initial meeting will prepare a representative from your agency to understand and deliver the Camp Internet program to the youth you serve whether at a Boys and Girls Club, Housing Authority Computer Center, Library, Museum, Girls Club, 4H, YMCA, or other afterschool program provider. We suggest sending your computer or history/science/art/reading program leader or other person qualified to deliver youth programming who will be with your agency through the end of 2002. Camp Internet's program activities can be presented to youth 1-5 days a week, depending on your agency's needs or interests – all that is required is at least one online computer at your facility and adult supervision. We also host special FAMILY DAYS for field trips and FAMILY NIGHTS for online learning activities that bring the generations together and into your Center for special programs
